

## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

How are your rhododendrons doing. Check adjacent trees and shrubs for overhanging branches which should be removed in case of snowfall. If you are collecting seed, they should be ripened by now so they should be picked and dried for early spring planting. What to do with the dead leaves under your rhododendrons? Your choice. They will break down and form a mulch for the plants. They are a good hiding place for black vine beetles and their predator beetles. In the last ARS journal there is an excellent article on this subject.


